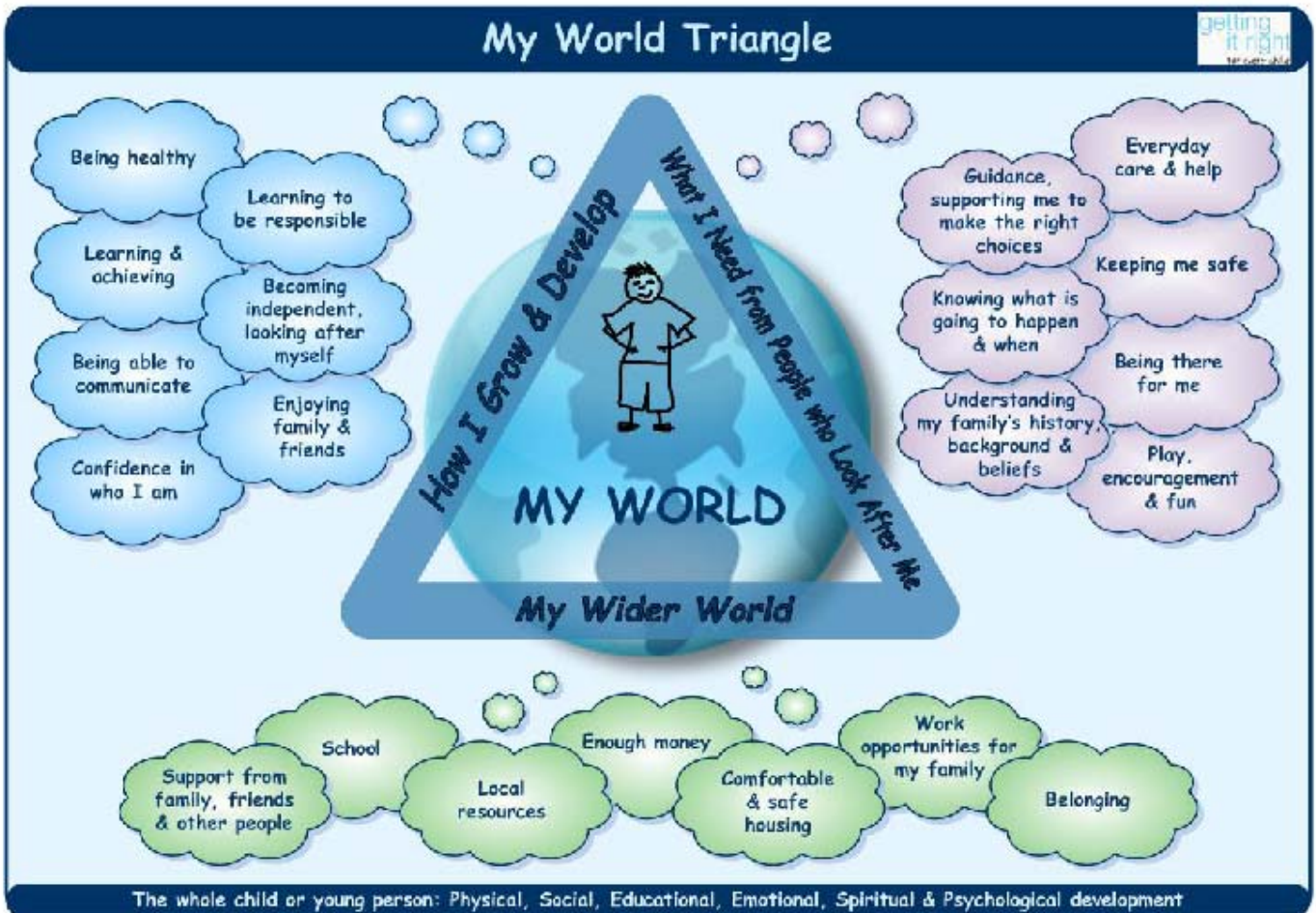


# My World Triangle



## OUTCOMES FOR CHILDREN

The outcomes for all children in Scotland are that they are:  
**Confident Individuals; Effective Contributors; Successful Learners; Responsible Citizens**

<b>Safe</b>	Protected from abuse, neglect or harm at home, at school and in the community.
<b>Healthy</b>	Having the highest attainable standards of physical & mental health, access to suitable health care & support to make healthy & safe choices.
<b>Achieving</b>	Being supported & guided in their learning & in the development of their skills; confidence & self esteem at home, at school & in the community.
<b>Nurtured</b>	Having a nurturing place to live, in a family setting with additional help if needed or, where this is not possible, in a suitable care setting.
<b>Active</b>	Having opportunities to take part in activities such as play, recreation & sport, which contribute to healthy growth & development at home and in the community.
<b>Respected &amp; Responsible</b>	Should be involved in decisions that affect them, should have their voices heard and should be encouraged to play an active and responsible role in their schools & communities.
<b>Included</b>	Having help to overcome social, educational, physical & economic inequalities and being accepted as part of the community in which they live & learn.
